ATE Impacts books: Internet Scout has created two editions of this publication with NSF funding. The first edition (2018-2019) was published in 2018 and the 2020-2021 edition (which is at the printer but delayed by the pandemic) both showcase the innovative resources, activities, partnerships, and impacts of the ATE community.

ATE Central Portal: A web portal that supports the mission of ATE Central to serve as an information hub and archive for NSF's Advanced Technological Education (ATE) community. The portal provides a database of metadata about ATE projects and centers, the resources they create or collect, community events, and an array of other tools and services to support ATE grantees and help amplify program impacts and disseminate program deliverables to a variety of stakeholders.

ATE@20 Book & Blog: In recognition of the 20th anniversary of the ATE program, Internet Scout Research Group, in collaboration with the ATE community, created a book and accompanying blog to celebrate grantee and programmatic impacts.

ATE PI Conference App: In collaboration with the American Association of Community Colleges

(AACC) Internet Scout supports creation of a mobile application to help PI Conference attendees to electronically access the conference program and showcase sessions, built their own customized schedule, find collaborators, and navigate the conference hotel.

CWIS Software: This open-source software package is being used all over the world for digital library and information portal projects. CWIS is designed to run in a LAMP environment, provides workflow support, and allows those with digital collections to easily search, share, and showcase their digital resources.
